

In September 2017 Ben Bullock will embark on his journey to ride a Hunter Motorcycle solo across the world. The journey will begin in Perth, Western Australia, with Ben travelling for approximately nine months, to his final destination in Perth, Scotland. The ride will be filmed and a documentary mini-series will feature the highlights of his epic ride, tasting, discovering and preparing regional dishes and places of interest in the areas through which he travels.

This is going to be one hell of a challenge, and that's where the important message behind this ride comes in. No challenge is too great – whatever life tosses up, you can make it through, and this motorbike journey symbolizes that challenge. "From Perth to Perth" is Registered Australian Charity and non-profit venture, partnered with mental health charities to raise funds and awareness for depression and suicide prevention.

The concept of this ride evolved from reflection on some dark days that Ben himself was once going through, feeling lost, disengaged and aimless. The ride looks to send a message and inspire people to go out "become involved" and "have a go", with all donations going straight to supporting mental health initiatives such as the Black Dog Ride, Lifeline WA, Beyond Blue and the Mental Health Law Centre. Depression is the third most burdensome disease in Australia and suicide claims 3 times more lives than road traffic deaths. It's time to talk about it.

### Who is Ben?

Benjamin Bullock, a 27-year-old lawyer, from Western Australia, is one of the star contestants in the ninth series of *MasterChef Australia*, which premiered on 1 May 2017. Besides his obvious talents as a chef, Ben is a very capable motorcycle enthusiast with many years of riding experience. Will Ben be able to complete this epic journey? We don't know, but what we do know, Ben is a passionate, caring guy who is ready to throw his heart and soul into bringing people together, raising funds for this worthy charity and reaching the finish line.



### The Journey

The journey commences on 2 September 2017 in Perth, Western Australia. After travelling up through Australia to the Northern Territory, Ben and his Hunter will board a flight in Darwin and head to Bali. From there they will travel through the Indonesian archipelago to Medan, where they will again board a ship, to Malaysia. The journey from there is entirely overland through to the UK. The ride will include some 30 countries, continuing through South East Asia, across Central Asia, into the Middle East, through Southern Europe and across into the United Kingdom to Ben's final stop in Perth, Scotland. The exact route will remain somewhat flexible, in order that Ben can capture any special events and things of interest that might be discovered along the way.



## Journey Updates

Regular updates of the journey will be uploaded and available for public viewing across a variety of social media channels including Facebook, Instagram and Youtube. Throughout the initial stages of the journey the team will be uploading short 3-5 minute videos.

Once sufficient footage has been recorded the team will begin to produce and release the first videos of the 6 part miniseries.

### **Tourism Promotion**

Although the primary object of this series is "Food and Cooking", in order to maximize the viewing audience, considerable focus will be dedicated to the culture, landscapes, attractions and other things of general interest that are experienced during the journey.

As such, this series will provide an invaluable opportunity for each country to not only showcase its cuisine, but to also present its culture and tourist attractions in a very unique format.
